2018 EASA Karsten Moholt Exceptional Achievement Award

We are very pleased to announce that the recipient of the Annual KM Award for 2018 is Thomas Ison, Sulzer Electromechanical Services. This prize is awarded annually by EASA European & World Chapter to promote young talents in the Electromechanical Service industry and their special achievements.
